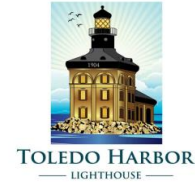

Dear Toledo Silent Auction Donor...

We were not able to have a festival in 2020. After a lot of discussion and assessment of the current status of COVID, we have decided to move the festival to September 11 & 12, hoping that this ensures that we will have a festival with few restrictions. The Toledo Lighthouse Festival is located on the shores of Lake Erie at Maumee Bay State Park. The festival will have great entertainment, arts and crafts village, boat tours, (weather permitting), huge silent auction, children's activities, lighthouse merchandise, food and more. We expect that the nautical arts and crafts village will fill up with over 60 exhibitors.

The 1904 Toledo lighthouse is a unique historic buff brick 4000 square foot with a cellar, three story tower and annex and a roof constructed like the upside down hull of a ship.

The Toledo Lighthouse Society is an all volunteer over 400 owners/members(all members are owners) nonprofit organization that took ownership of the lighthouse in 2008. The lighthouse society seeks to promote, educate and restore the Toledo lighthouse. The festival promotes the Toledo lighthouse and raises funds for the lighthouse restoration. The restored lighthouse will have four 'Keepers' at the lighthouse welcoming guests for tours. The lighthouse festival is the main fund raiser to help the lighthouse. Thousands attend the festival.

The first phase of the lighthouse exterior restoration of the lighthouse that puts in windows and shutters along with brick work and several doors restored on the first and second floors began in August 2020 and will be completed in May/June 2021. The restoration gives us a feel for what the lighthouse was like when 'Keepers' were at the lighthouse. This is a \$638,000 project funded with a \$500,000 federal/state/county grant, a \$20,000 grant from Cleveland Cliffs and a \$118,000 loan. About \$2 million is needed to complete the restoration so 'Keeper's' can welcome the public via boats to the lighthouse.

Your donation to the Silent Auction will help the Toledo Lighthouse Restoration continue. Let's keep the restoration going by helping with a silent auction donation. Once restoration is completed, there will be 'Keepers' at the lighthouse from May through September to offer tours of the lighthouse. Boaters and sailors will be able to pull up to the lighthouse and see the amazing 4000 square foot structure with three floors and a three story spiral stair case tower. The Toledo Lighthouse will be a Lake Erie tourist showcase when completed.

All types of donations for the silent auction are needed. From gift cards to sports events to theatre to landscaping or maybe you have a condo that you could offer for a week or a boat for a private tour around the lighthouse or...

The over 200 item silent auction is a major fund raiser at the festival and will help to continue the restoration.

All proceeds, net of festival costs, go toward historic preservation, restoration and access for the lighthouse.
